Auty is perhaps best known for his work on TV series, having produced the ratings hits 'Heartbeat' and 'A Touch of Frost' during the 1990s; however, he has also produced a variety of other styles of films and TV programs including 'Lenny Live and Unleashed', 'Soul Survivors' and 'Gentlemen's Relish'. The latter, which starred Billy Connolly, was made for the BBC in 2001. He returned to TV in 2009 shooting a new series of 'A Touch of Frost'.

Martyn has recently shifted his focus to making motion pictures, after producing 'A Foreign Field' (1993), 'Heidi' (2005) and most recently, 'Ways To Live Forever' (2010).

Christian Beetz, founder and CEO of beetz brothers film productions, is one of the most important documentary film producers of Germany. Under his leadership, beetz brothers film productions has realised more than 120 high-quality documentaries for the international market and, according to the leading industry publication Realscreen, has emerged as one of today's top 100 international independent film production companies. The company's productions compete regularly at all major international film festivals and have won numerous prestigious awards, including three Grimme Awards (Farewell Comrades!; Between Insanity and Beauty), the Cinema for Peace Award (Blood in the Mobile), three British Independent Awards (Saving the Titanic), the Prix Europa (FC Barcelona), the Hot Docs Special Jury Prize (Before the Last Curtain Falls; Autumn Gold) and the IDFA Special Jury Award (Nelson Mandela - The Myth and Me). In 2013, the beetz brothers' co-production Open Heart was even nominated for an Academy Award® and in 2014, the documentary The Wagner Files was nominated for the International Emmy® Award for Best Arts Programming. This year, the co-production The Land of the Enlightened has its world premiere at the Sundance Filmfestival 2016 in the competition.

The focus of the *beetz brothers'* output is on the fields of history, culture and society and productions range from feature-film and television documentaries to docudramas and TV series. Presently, the company annually produces a select number of internationally cofinanced television and cinema narrative films.

Space Rocket Nation ApS was founded on January 1st, 2008 by producer Lene Børglum and director Nicolas Winding Refn after their successful collaboration on Nicolas Winding Refn's feature film Valhalla Rising.

Space Rocket Nation aims to produce highly artistic and edgy feature films for an international audience by Nicolas Winding Refn, as well as to build up a new generation of edgy, artistic directors and help them reach the international audience.

Lene Børglum was one of the key persons and co-owner of Zentropa from its early start in 1992 and until 2007 when she left to start up Space Rocket Nation with Nicolas Winding Refn. In her position as expert in international financing she handled international financing on a large number of Zentropa's international films, including Lars von Trier's highly acclaimed and awarded films The Kingdom I and II, the Idiots, Breaking the Waves, Dancer in the Dark, and was Executive Producer on Trier's Dogville, Manderlay and the Boss of it All. Thereafter, she has been executive producer on Swedish director Lukas Moodysson's first English language feature film "Mammoth" and Nicolas Winding Refn's "Valhalla Rising". In Space Rocket Nation, she has produced Refn's Only God Forgives and is in post production with his next film "The Neon Demon", and is in development of Refn's next feature film The Avenging Silence set in China and Japan, as well as a number of other films.
